DCU will emphasise confidence in speaking skills, and students will be tasked with in-class coursework that focuses on communication development skills. Testing – Pre Arrival	Students will take the DCU ‘Online Language Assessment’ six weeks before course commencement.			
Class Levels Offered	DCU offers tuition at seven levels – (1) <i>Beginner</i> , (2) <i>Elementary</i> , (3) <i>Pre Intermediate</i> , (4) <i>Intermediate</i> , (5) <i>Upper Intermediate</i> , (6) <i>Advanced</i> , (7) <i>Proficient</i> . Students will be placed to a level-appropriate class based on their performance in the Online Language Assessment.			
Course Materials	1x Coursebook and 1x Student Journal provided. Students required to bring pens and notepaper.			
Ongoing Assessment	Students will be evaluated primarily by continuous assessment in-programme.
